Planning Commission; Meeting was held on December 7. All members were present. Kevin Hjelmgren attended the meeting to discuss water issues on his property. It was determined his property is out of the Towns jurisdiction so any fixes will be there responsibility.

Village of Baldwin representatives attended the meeting to discuss the annexation of the Wally Nelson property.

Agenda:

Hammond Recycle Program, Linda discussed with the board some updates to the County Recycle program and how it will affect our recycle grant in the future. Also the fact that our current \$60 fee may not be able to sustain our program as it is today we will have to continue to monitor and look for ways to keep it successful.

The board set the Caucus date for January 11, 2021.

Roads:

Paul reported that we spent \$267,392.41 on roads this year. Our budget was \$394,621.00.

We spent \$57,272.19 on the June storm damage; the state will reimburse us \$42,954.14.

Chairman report:

Paul talked about the possibility of purchasing a sanitizing machine for the fire department. If we do participate it would cost approximately \$1700 per municipality and the Town could use it quarterly to sanitize our building, more discussion to continue.
