Paul updated Planning on discussion of electric service for Concession Building being planned. Paul spoke to St Croix Electric and to run the power would be estimated at \$2625.00. Planning suggests installation cost and annual expense (till usage is excessive) to be covered by Town of Hammond. Send to full board for approval.

Paul was contacted by Dean Doornink about field driveways in two places located on 200th St. One south of J by bridge and one north of railroad tracks.

Paul discussed we will need develop a Road Restriction Ordinance to have authorization to post and enforce road postings and any damages incurred.

Paul stated the Road Restrictions are removed 4/5/21. Paul updated road repair plans, Spray patch/Chip Seal & Fog Seal. (Rolling Hills, Emerald Acres, Hammond Oaks plus some roads.

Paul discussed how the Federal Stimulus will affect us locally. Wisconsin will receive approx. 360 million and of that our Township would receive \$232990.60 divided over two years. Waited for criteria and rules for use.
