Planning Commission; Met on August 7, 2023, all members present. Scott Madsen was in attendance requesting 90th Ave. be open to UTV/ATV 's from 190th Street west to county road T, and the 90th Ave. Cul-de-sac open to his residence. Greg O'Connell brought up the Farmland Preservation Program in a discussion. Paul will look into this in more detail. Paul received a request to make 170th St. and 100th Ave a 4 way stop. He applied a red reflective tape on the post to see if this would help prior to a 4 way stop.

Airport requested and received a conditional use permit for an addition to the existing building. The Town has some concerns about this as the airport is already not in compliance with other issues.
