Agenda:

Eric Host, Jason Jacobs and Lindsay Olson were in attendance for the SCC Rec. They discussed possibly adding 2 low profile job boxes at the ball field for storage. Paul suggested they place the boxes behind the concession stand and maybe pour a concrete slab for them to rest on. They also asked to have gates put on the fence openings for safety concerns. Future dugouts and fencing extending to the outfield. Bleachers were also discussed; they have the chance to get them for free from the Hammond Lions Foundation. Paul wants to see them first before making a decision.

Roads:

Road restrictions were put into place, some roads are already beginning to break up. St. Croix County will be reviewing our 20-foot bridges (culverts) along with the bridge inspections.

Chairmans report: Paul reported that there are still issues at the Sarango (190th) residence with building code violations. Mr. Sarango will have to come before the board with plans prior to issuing any more permits. Linda will send a letter to him.
