Paul H. stated that the Planning Commission will continue working on the Fire Inspector Ordinance and asked the Planning Commission to review the Developers Agreement before the next meeting.

Chairmans' Report

Paul H. discussed the Road and Bridge Inspections in the Town. He updated us that the Town received 2.6 million dollars of Building Permit applications in April.

Paul H. on ATV/UTV signs, Greg Olson had a few questions about where UTV/ATV signs need to be added or changed. Greg Olson from local club will address, Locator will be required for installation of one post prior to installation.

Paul H. discussed installation of posts and reflectors on the curve on County Road J to prevent drivers from cutting the corner through the right of way/ditch.

The June meeting will be on Monday 6/1/2026, there will be a Public Hearing for the presentation/approval of the Town Comprehensive Plan.
