The commission worked on the comprehensive plan final draft for presentation at the June 1, public meeting.

They will continue to work on the Fire Inspector Ordinance.

Greg Olson had some questions about were UTV/ATV signs need to be added or changed.

Paul presented a plan to install posts and reflectors on 70th Ave. to prevent drivers from driving through the ROW and ditch.

Paul explained to him that if a complaint is received and animal control has to go out, someone has to pay the bill. Pat disagreed. Roads: Only maintenance on the roads this year. Will replace the 45MPH sign on 150th & 70th. Looking at paving the cul de sac in Forest View Ridge, Getting estimates from County.

County will be taking down a tree on 150th. Shoulder work will start in Rolling Hills. Will be chip sealing approximately 8-9 miles. Looking at possibly doing some fogging in some cul de sacs.

Chairman: Talked about the ditches on 110th, steeper grade harder to maintain
